JAPANESE AS STUDENTS
DURING WWII. THAT'S WHY
IN 1956 MICHIGAN STATE
WAS THE FIRST MAJOR
UNIVERSITY IN THE U.S. WITH
A DEAN OF INTERNATIONAL
PROGRAMS. THAT'S WHY IN
1957 JOHN HANNAH WAS
THE FIRST CHAIRMAN OF
THE U.S. COMMISSION ON
CIVIL RIGHTS. THAT'S WHY
IN THE 1970S MIGRANT
    RKERS' CHILDREN WERE
OFFERED IN-STATE TUITION.
That's why in 1972 East
LANSING BECAME THE FIRST
COMMUNITY IN THE NATION
TO ENACT CIVIL RIGHTS
PROTECTIONS FOR THE
LGBT COMMUNITY. THAT'S
WHY IN 1972 WE BECAME
A VOICE FOR STUDENTS
WITH DISABILITIES
THROUGH A DESIGNATED
PROGRAM. THAT'S WHY
IN 1981 THE NATIVE
AMERICAN INSTITUTE
